NARRATIVE: On September 11th, 2025, Clinton County Sheriff Deputies arrested Daniel Solomon following a traffic stop in the Village of Rouses Point. It is alleged that Solomon had no lighting equipment on his bicycle while operating on a public roadway and that he was riding in oncoming lanes of traffic failing to keep to the right as required when there is no defined bike lane. Upon interview, Solomon provided Deputies with a false name.

DISPOSITION: Daniel Solomon was processed at the Clinton County Sheriff's Office and custody was transferred to State Police in Plattsburgh for active warrants. Solomon is scheduled to appear in the Town of Champlain Court on a later date to face the allegations.
