**DATE AND TIME OF ARREST: 10/12/2021 at 7:36 p.m.**

**NARRATIVE:** On the above date and time, Clinton County Sheriff Deputies arrested Jared Lashway on the above listed charges after responding to a call for an alleged intoxicated male trespassing at a residence in the Town of Mooers. During the course of the investigation, Lashway kicked a Deputy resulting in physical injury and attempted to flee the scene on foot. Lashway was apprehended after a short foot chase, following which he allegedly kicked a New York State Trooper. After being secured in the sheriff's vehicle, Lashway caused significant damage to it, in excess of \$1,500.

**DISPOSITION:** Lashway was arraigned in the Town of Mooers Court. Lashway was subsequently remanded to the Clinton County Correctional Facility in lieu of \$10,000 cash bail. He is scheduled to return to the Town of Mooers Court to face the allegations. Deputies were assisted in the arrest by New York State Police. The Deputy was sent for medical evaluation and both, Deputy and Trooper, were returned to duty.
