**DATE AND TIME OF ARREST:** 10/19/2023 at 10:26pm

**NARRATIVE:** On October 19, 2023, at around 10:03pm, Clinton County Sheriff's Deputies attempted to initiate a traffic stop on a vehicle in the Town of Beekmantown. The vehicle failed to comply with the Sheriff's Deputies attempt to stop it and led Deputies on a pursuit that ended in the Town of Peru at around 10:26pm, following which the operator of the vehicle, Breyer A. Rock, was taken into custody. It's alleged that during the pursuit Rock intentionally caused damage to a Clinton County Sheriff's Office patrol vehicle and various other private property. Rock was charged with reckless endangerment due to him allegedly nearly striking a New York State Trooper. It's also alleged that Rock was operating the vehicle without the permission of the registered owner.

**DISPOSITION:** Rock was processed at the Sheriff's Office and released after being issued appearance tickets returnable to Peru Town Court on a later date. Rock was also ticketed for multiple vehicle and traffic violations in the Town of Plattsburgh and Town of Beekmantown. Deputies were assisted in the case by the New York State Police.
