**DATE AND TIME OF ARREST: 10/28/2018 at 01:06 a.m.**

**NARRATIVE: On October 28<sup>th</sup> 2018, Clinton County Sheriff Deputies arrested Nathan K. Mausert of Saratoga Springs following a vehicle and traffic stop in the City of Plattsburgh. Deputies observed Mausert to be allegedly operating without lights and his motor vehicle to have significant front end damage. Mausert then failed to obey police for a short distance before stopping and being taken into custody. Upon further investigation, it was determined that Mausert had left the scene of a property damage accident and was allegedly operating in an intoxicated condition.**

**DISPOSITION: Mausert was transported to the Clinton County Sheriff's Office for processing. He was later released on appearance tickets returnable to the City of**

**Plattsburgh Court. Clinton County Sheriff Deputies were assisted by members of the New York State Police, Plattsburgh State University Police and Plattsburgh City Police.**
