**NARRATIVE:** On December 23, 2021 at approximately 1049 hours, Clinton County Sheriff's Deputies responded to the area of State Route 22 in the Town of Beekmantown for a reported two car motor vehicle collision with injury. It is alleged that Anna M. Duprey was operating a 2008 Dodge Ram, traveling north on State Route 22, when she failed to yield the right of way to a 2017 Honda Accord, being operated by Kristin D. Nephew. The front of Duprey's vehicle collided with the front of Nephew's vehicle. Both operators, including a minor, were transported by ambulance to University of Vermont – Champlain Valley Physicians Hospital for complaints of head, neck and chest pain.

**DISPOSITION:** At the time of press release, all individuals were still being evaluated at CVPH but are expected to make a full recovery with no serious physical injuries reported. The Sheriff's Office was assisted by Beekmantown Fire Department, District 3 Fire Department and CVPH EMS.
