**NARRATIVE:** On February 18, 2015, shortly after 5pm, Sheriff's Deputies responded to the intersection of Ashley Road and Spellman Road in the Town of Beekmantown for a report of a two car motor vehicle accident. An investigation at the scene revealed that Alison Carter was operating a 2013 Subaru Impreza south on Ashley Road when she failed to stop at the stop sign located at the intersection with Spellman Road. Ms. Carter proceeded into the intersection and struck a 2003 Volkswagen being operated by Samantha Pope which was traveling east on Spellman Road.

**DISPOSITION:** Both vehicles were heavily damaged and had to be towed from the scene. Samantha Pope was transported to CVPH Medical Center for apparent minor injuries and was later released. Alison Carter and the two other passengers involved were not injured. Ms. Carter was ticketed for failure to stop at a stop sign. Beekmantown Fire Department and CVPH EMS responded to the scene.
