CHARGES: VTL 1180A Speed Not Reasonable and Prudent (viol) VTL 1128D Drove across hazard markings (viol) VTL 501B1A Operating with non-supervisor as front seat occupant (viol) VTL 5092 Operating out of class (viol) VTL 1128A Moved from lane unsafely (viol)

DATE AND TIME OF ACCIDENT: 04/04/2015 1751 hours

NARRATIVE: On the date listed above Sheriff's Deputies responded to a report of a one car rollover at Calkins road and Fred Thew Road in the Town of Peru. Deputies arrived to find the occupants were out of the vehicle. The Operator and his passenger were transported by CVPH University of Vermont Health Network Ambulances. The operator, Nastasia was issued UTT's for the above infractions. The status of both parties is unknown at this time. New York State Environmental Conservation Police and the New York State Police also responded and assisted at the scene. Fire and EMS Crews from Peru and Keeseville were dispatched.

DISPOSITION: The investigation into the cause of the accident has been concluded and UTT's issued.
