DATE AND TIME OF ARREST: August 18, 2012 1645 hrs approximately

NARRATIVE: The Clinton County Sheriff's Department is investigating a leaving the scene of a personal injury car versus bicycle accident. This accident occurred on the Moffitt Road in the vicinity of the south-bound on ramp for Interstate 87. The time of the accident was approximately 4:45pm on August 18, 2012. The investigation determined that Rasario Farnhan (28 years of age, male) was riding his black and white in color Thruster BMX bike in a northerly direction on the Moffitt Road when he was struck from behind by an unknown vehicle. The accident caused the victim to be ejected from the bicycle and loose consciousness on the side of the road. The vehicle then fled the scene. A near-by witness to the accident observed a white in color car, unknown make and model, with a female driver and a child passenger in the area at the time of the accident. The child exited the vehicle and moved the bike to the other side of the road. Rasario was transported to CVPH for treatment of his minor injuries. The investigation is ongoing, and the Sheriff's Department is encouraging anyone with information, or any autobody shops that may encounter a vehicle with front end damage, to contact the Sheriff's Department at 518-565-4340.
