NARRATIVE: On the above date and time, Sheriff's Deputies responded to State Route 3 in the Town of Plattsburgh, just west of Five Guys, for report of a car versus pedestrian personal injury accident. Investigation at the scene revealed that Tammy Menard of Morrisonville was operating a 2008 Honda west on Route 3, when a female pedestrian, Elizabeth Crespo of Plattsburgh, ran in front of her vehicle while attempting to cross Route 3 from the southern to northern side. Menard was unable to avoid Crespo and struck her with her vehicle.

DISPOSITION: Crespo was transported from the scene to UVM CVPH Medical Center for treatment of minor lacerations, contusions and head and neck pain. Crespo was wearing dark clothing and was not in a crosswalk at the time of the incident. She was also allegedly under the influence of alcohol at the time of the incident. Crespo was ticketed by Deputies for failure to yield the right of way to vehicular traffic. Deputies were assisted at the scene by UVM CVPH EMS, District 3 Fire Department and New York State Police.
