On Monday April 5, 2010 deputies from the Clinton County Sheriff's Office filed an additional charge against that Altona New York man who attempted to flee deputies on his motorcycle after they tired to pull him over.

The additional charge of misdemeanor unlawful fleeing a Police Officer was filed against 37-year-old Derek Campbell.

Campbell attempted to flee deputies on Saturday April 3, 2010 after they observed him on his motorcycle trying to pass a vehicle on the double yellow line. Deputies clocked Campbell at speeds in excess of 88 miles-per-hour.

The new charge stems from the fact that Campbell reached speeds that were in excess of 25 miles-per-hour over the posted speed limit while fleeing from deputies.

Campbell was previously charged with misdemeanor driving while intoxicated, misdemeanor reckless driving four other offenses: Failure to obey a police officer, speeding, refusing to take a breath test and driving to the left of pavement markings.

Campbell is scheduled to appear in Plattsburgh Town Court on April 8, 2010 to face the allegations.
