A distracted driver is responsible for causing a car vs. motorcycle accident during rush-hour Tuesday.

Clinton County Sheriff's Office deputies say 28-year-old Cory McCasland of Saranac was operating a Kawasaki motorcycle around 5:30p.m. on Tom Miller Road.

McCasland apparently became distracted and hit the back of a Nissan Sedan driven by 50-year-old Michael LaBrake of Plattsburgh. LaBrake's vehicle was stopped in traffic at the time it was hit by McCasland.

McCasland and LaBrake were both treated by EMS at the scene for minor injuries and refused transport to the hospital.
