An Ausable Forks New York woman who deputies say was driving down the wrong side of the road will now face charges for DWI.

22-year-old Antonette Knoedl was stopped by Sheriff's Deputies on Broad Street in the City of Plattsburgh around 2:00a.m. Sunday November 7, 2010 after deputies reportedly observed Knoedl driving erratically down the wrong side of the street.

Knoedl failed field sobriety tests administered by deputies. She was taken to the Clinton County Sheriffs Office for processing. Knoedl submitted to a breath test which showed her to be legally intoxicated.

Deputies charged Knoedl with misdemeanor aggravated DWI and failure to keep right.

Knoedl was released into the custody of a third party and due to appear in Plattsburgh City Court on November 12, 2010 to face the charges.
