A Peru New York woman is facing felony DWI charges.

35-year-old Heather Stone was stopped by sheriff's deputies on Saturday September 25, 2010 just before midnight on Route 3 in the Town of Plattsburgh after deputies reportedly observed her making an illegal turn.

Stone failed field sobriety tests administered by deputies and was taken to the Clinton County Sheriffs Office for processing. Stone submitted to a breath test which showed her to be legally intoxicated.

Stone, who had a previous conviction for DWI in 2000, was charged with Felony DWI. Deputies also charged stone with failing to obey a traffic control device.

Stone was released into the custody of a third party and will appear in Plattsburgh Town Court on October 7, 2010 to face the charges.

Sunday September 26, 2010

A Plattsburgh woman who was convicted of an alcohol-related offense just 90 days ago is now facing new charges for being under the influence of drugs and alcohol.

21-year-old Natalie Monzeglio was stopped by sheriff's deputies on Sunday September 26, 2010 just before 2:00a.m. on Route 22 in the Town of Plattsburgh after deputies observed her driving erratically in the roadway.

Montzeglio failed field sobriety tests administered by deputies and was taken to the Clinton County Sheriffs Office for processing. Montzeglio submitted to breath and blood tests.

Deputies charged Montzeglio with one count of misdemeanor DWAI- Drugs and one count of misdemeanor DWI. Deputies also ticketed Montzeglio for crossing the hazard markings in the road.

Montzeglio was previously convicted of DWAI on June 7, 2010. She will appear in Plattsburgh Town Court on October 7, 2010 to face the new charges.
