On Tuesday March 16, 2010 the Clinton County Sheriff's Office charged a local man with unlawful possession of drugs and DWI.

19-year-old Kyle Redden of Peru was arrested at 3:30a.m while driving south bound on Interstate 87 near exit 36.

Deputies pulled Redden over after they observed his vehicle swerve in the roadway and almost hit a guard rail. During the stop Redden reportedly admitted to having marijuana in the vehicle.

Redden failed field sobriety tests administered by deputies. He was taken to the Clinton County Sheriff's Office for processing. Redden submitted to a breath test which showed his blood alcohol level to be two-times the legal limit.

Deputies charged Redden with one count of misdemeanor DWI. He was also charged with two other violations: unlawful possession of marijuana and unsafe lane change.

Redden was released to the custody of a third party and will appear in Plattsburgh Town Court on April 5, 2010 to face the allegations.
