A Morrisonville New York man who was driving without a license and who tried to flee from Sheriff's Deputies is now facing his second DWI charge in less than ten days.

Deputies from the Clinton County Sheriff's Office arrested 28-year-old Shawn Tuper just before 11:00p.m. on Wednesday September 1, 2010 on Harpp Street in Morrisonville.

Deputies attempted to pull Tuper over on Banker Road in the Town of Plattsburgh after they observed an equipment violation on his vehicle, but he failed to stop and continued driving to his residence in Morrisonville.

Tuper failed field sobriety tests administered by deputies. He was taken into custody and brought the Clinton County Sheriff's Office for processing.

Tuper was charged with one count of misdemeanor DWI, and one count of misdemeanor aggravated unlicensed operation of a motor vehicle. He was also charged with failure to obey a police officer and driving with insufficient tail lights.

Tuper was previously charged with DWI on August 24, 2010.

He will appear in Plattsburgh Town Court at a later date to face the charges.
