A Morrisonville New York woman who sheriff's deputies say drove at a high rate of speed through a parking lot under the influence of drugs with a 5-year-old child in her car will now face felony charges under the states Leandra's Law.

Deputies from the Clinton County Sheriff's Office arrested 24-year-old Britteny Woodside on Friday October 1, 2010 just before 10:00p.m. in the Town of Plattsburgh.

Deputies stopped Woodside after they observed her driving at a high rate of speed through a parking lot near the intersection of Rugar Street and Military Turnpike in order to avoid driving through the intersection.

During the stop deputies discovered marijuana and drug paraphernalia in Woodside's vehicle.

Woodside failed field sobriety tests administered by deputies. She was taken to the Clinton County Sheriff's Office for processing.

Deputies charged Woodside with one misdemeanor count of DWAI-drugs. She was additionally charged with one felony count of aggravated DWI under the states Leandra's Law which makes it a felony to operate a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs with a child in the vehicle.

Deputies also charged Woodside with unlawfully possession of marijuana and multiple vehicle traffic law infractions. She was released to the custody of a third party and will appear in Plattsburgh Town Court on October 14, 2010 to face the charges.
