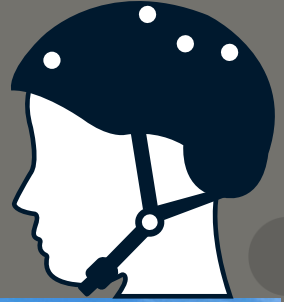
Education

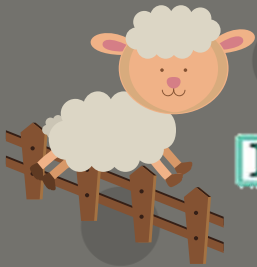

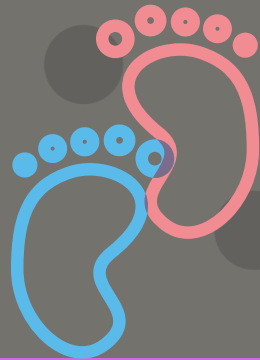
Bicycle Safety
